Tuning Instructions

First of all, we have to number our strings from the lowest to the highest pitch, in this order:

No. of each string	1	2	3	4	5	6	7
Note of each string	G3	A3	B3	С4	D4	E4	F4

There are many tuning apps available, both for Android and iOS devices. Some of them are free, and some are not. Unfortunately, there is no tuning app right now specifically for a lyre. The good news is that a guitar tuning app is more than enough!

Below are our favorites tuning apps for mobile devices and tablets, but you don't need to stick with them. Don't hesitate to search for "tuning" in GooglePlay or AppStore and try out some of them before choosing the right one for you.

Pitched Tuner (Android and iOS devices)

Important Notice:

While using a tuner or a tuning app, you will notice a number next to the letters of each note. This number shows in which octave your note belongs to.

So, while tuning, make sure that each string is tuned to the correct note and the correct octave. Therefore, for example, when you tune your 1st string on the note G, make sure that it is tuned to the note G3, your 2nd string on the note A3, and so on.
